**Audrey Hepburn**

- 4 May 1929 – 20 January 1993  
British actress and humanitarian
- She was ranked by the American Film Institute as the third greatest female screen legend in the history of American cinema.
- Hepburn remains one of few people who have won Academy, Emmy, Grammy, and Tony Awards.
- She was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom in recognition of her work as a UNICEF Goodwill Ambassador in late 1992.
